INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

- 1. Abstracts accepted for presentation will be published in the congress syllabus, and will appear as typed after a moderate reduction. Abstracts must be written in English; abstracts written in other languages will not be accepted.
- 2. Use single line spacing. Typing must be wholly within the box, using typescript of 9 or 10 pitch, text-style ARIAL.
- 3. The TITLE should be in capitals. AUTHORS' names should follow, without starting a new line. The name of the author who will present, if the paper is scheduled for verbal presentation rather than poster, should be underlined. Omit degrees and titles. The author's names should be followed by the name and the location(s) where the work was done. Please do not indicate the name of your institution in the title of the abstract or in the text
- 4. The BODY of the abstract should start, without an indent, after leaving one blank line below the title, authors, etc.; it should include:
 - A sentence or two stating of the study's objectives.
 - A brief statement of the methods used.
 - A summary of the results.
 - A statement of conclusions (it is not satisfactory to say that "the results will be discussed").
 - Tables, figures and 1-3 references may be included, but must fit within the space allocated.
- Be sure that all boxes on the front of the form have been completed.
