Content :	<p>Contents: - pronunciation in context, the alphabet and its Latin transcription, putting words in alphabetic order, reading and writing, first word vocabulary, word accentuation; - basic conjugations and declensions: normal verbs, simple special verbs, normal and special nouns and adjectives, table of increased verbs; - basic syntax: attributive adjectives, determining nouns, prepositional complements, non-prepositional circumstantial complements, nominal sentences, verbal sentences. Methods: - preparation at home and active participation are required; - written exercises at home, written and spoken exercises in class.</p>
