Aims:	At the end of the course, the successful students will be able - to distinguish the components of the act of teaching in physical education: state, regulate, devoluate and institutionalize. - to identify the elements rely on the task and the motivation of the pupil to enhance motor learning's. - to establish essential links between erudite knowledge's and experience knowledge's acquired during training courses in observation and teaching in secondary school, under supervision of an expert. They will develop the bases of a reflexion on his practice. - to understand principles of the management of teenager's groups and the principles of the animation of educational teams.
