IBL Chair - Seminar - Conflict and cooperation between the EU and Russia in the Former Soviet Union

Main themes :	Conflicts will be analyzed under various angles: - Ethnic dimensions; - Cultural dimensions; - Historical power rivalries; - Economic interests and access to natural resources; - Diplomatic means used in conflicts (bilateral diplomacy, international organizations, regional organizations, contact groups) and their efficiency.
Aims:	In this seminar, students will be asked to analyze a series of actual or possible conflicts in the post-soviet space: Caucasus, Eastern Europe, and Central Asia. They will prepare presentations and handle group discussions with invited speakers.
