Main themes :	The course allows student to : compare their mutual experiences and take a critical distance from the practical observations made during de internships ; - analyse the pedagogical practises observed and applied during their observation and teaching internships ; - develop the use of conceptual reference and analyse frameworks in order to develop a fruitful approach of their own practices. Moreover, this course will give students the chance to analyse and subsequently present the methodological difficulties encountered and the solutions proposed.
Aims :	At the end of the course, students will be able to reflect critically on their practical internship experience in connection with the theories developed during general and discipline specific didactics courses.
