Place of the course	Louvain-la-Neuve
Main themes :	The course is focused on the philological study of Old Church Slavonic : writing, morphology text history ; points of syntax will be touched upon during the reading of texts (essentially from the gospels).
Aims :	At the end of the course, the student will know the fundamentals of Old Church Slavonic Grammar (Cyrillic writing, phonological alternations, morphology, syntax, vocabulary) and will be able to read and interpret autonomously texts of intermediate difficulty. <i>The contribution of this Teaching Unit to the development and command of the skills and learning outcomes of the programme(s) can be accessed at the end of this sheet, in the section entitled "Programmes/courses offering this Teaching Unit".</i>
Content :	1) Exposition of following chapters : philological introduction to the Old Church Slavonic language ; study of the alphabet ; morphology and syntax ; 2) reading and grammatical analysis of Old Slavonic texts, which are prepared by the student.
