Main themes :	Based on programs of instruction as provided in the French-speaking Community of Belgium, and with support from examples of sequences in instruction, the course will cover: - aims, objectives and methods that are appropriate in courses of human sciences, other than history; - aims, objectives and methods that are appropriate for the teaching of history and human sciences to students in certifying or professional programs.
Aims:	Upon completion of the course the student should be able to distinguish the proper emphases as regards: - teaching in the human sciences (other than history) at the secondary level in general; - teaching history and human sciences in certifiying and professional instruction. Content :	The course is comprised of theoretical lectures, analyse of exemples of lessons and practical exercises.
