Main themes :	The seminar intends to look further into specific problems in a selection of works of contemporary Spanish literature thanks to the systematic application of a given methodology.
Aims :	The student will receive in this seminar the grounding necessary to carry out a research task in the field of contemporary Spanish literature and to take part in a scholarly debate in this field. <i>The contribution of this Teaching Unit to the development and command of the skills and learning outcomes of the programme(s) can be accessed at the end of this sheet, in the section entitled "Programmes/courses offering this Teaching Unit".</i>
Content :	The focus is on the personal and rigorous learning of a precise methodology for the analysis of contemporary Spanish works. Students also practice the techniques necessary for the oral and written presentation of a research task, and those that should help them to develop a critical report relating both to their own thought processes and to those of others.
Other infos :	Other information (Prerequisite, Evaluation, Course materials etc.) Prerequisite: Advanced Spanish level. Evaluation will be on the basis of participation by the student and the presentation of written and oral work. Course materials: Selection of works, articles, and reference works. An individualised framework is proposed to students during and after the preparation of their talks.
