Main themes :	The following topics will be approached: -impact of linguistic and cultural factors on the school success; - linguistic and cultural specificities of pupils stemming from immigration, related with the training of oral and written French and more generally with French as schooling language; - treatment of linguistic and cultural diversity on the various levels of the school institution.
Aims:	At the end of the course, the students will be able - to analyze the linguistic and cultural situation of young people stemming from immigration and to understand the most current errors of these pupils in connection to their langue/culture of origin; - to make arrangements for possible transfers of implements of French as foreign or second language (FLES) and as teaching language; - to work out didactic plans for teaching in a multicultural context.
