Main themes :	According to the interests of the students, the course will focus on the chemical, pharmacological or analytical aspects of one specific class of natural active molecules.
Aims:	The aim of this course is to increase the knowledge of the student on one defined class of natural compounds, their structures, sources, pharmacological properties and/or quantification and quality control methods. Content :	The student will realise an exhaustive bibliographical study on a topic chosen in collaboration with the teacher.
