Main themes :	- introduction to the accompanied practice, the European standard - installation and practical organization of a home practice, a group practice or a regional framework,- organization of the continuity of care, contribution of data processing to the practice of the general medicine - implementing new medical diagnosis and care tools in general medicine - legal responsibility and legal documents (certificates) - application of criteria of quality assurance in general medicine; implementation of guidelines and standards of quality in his practice.
