Main themes :	The following conditions will be approached by considering the intellectual and exploratory paths from the evocation of its complaint by the patient until the therapeutic proposition : otoscopic and endoscopic exam of the middle ear ; facial paralysis; cholesteatoma; the hard-of-hearing child ; vertigo and Menière's disease ; nasal obstruction ; rhinorrhea ; epistaxis ; strategy and antibiotherapy in the ENT field ; emergency ; dysphonia ; dysphagia ; cervical tumefaction ; postoperative care in laryngeal surgery and head and neck emergencies.
