The written exam takes place the last week before the students "study vacation".</p>
Teaching methods :	<p>LANGL1841 is an online course. All students must practice their English during the academic year, even those who passed the placement test. However, students who scored more than 10/20 at the placement test do not have to subscribe to ALTISSIA.</p> <p>Remediation online course: Altissia is used for weaker students who scored less than 10/20 at the placement test. The online platform enables them to catch up and reach a B2 level at the end of the year.</p> <p>Moodle ANGL1841: This platform is used to propose online activities to all students. Those activities deal with topics connected with their studies. Thanks to online tests, students can also test their understanding of the grammar and vocabulary that they have to study.</p>
