Prerequisites :	The students registered for the didactic finality or for the teaching certificate can follow as from the first year.
Main themes :	Strengthening of one teaching area of French as first language and set up of a scientific methodology suited to the research in the area in question. 15 hours of seminar, with groups of 15 to 20 students.
Aims :	To learn how to integrate oneself in a process of research of didactic for French by trying out tools and methods related to a specific issue of the teaching of French. <i>The contribution of this Teaching Unit to the development and command of the skills and learning outcomes of the programme(s) can be accessed at the end of this sheet, in the section entitled "Programmes/courses offering this Teaching Unit".</i>
Evaluation methods :	An essay of 15 pages.
Teaching methods :	Working in groups of 15 to 20 students supported by the professor and/or by an assistant. Research activities in very small groups will alternate with exchanges in the entire group.
Content :	The seminar introduces the main principles and methods of research into teaching French, particularly the analysis of teaching methods and the effect they have on pupils. On this basis, students will discover and compare different examples of research already undertaken and try out for themselves a research measure relating to activities for teaching learners reading writing, speaking, language or literature.
