Main themes :	Based on structure activity relationship, pharmacodynamy, toxicology, pharmacokinetic genomis and physicochemical properties of drugs, the student will integrate and discuss the different concepts and steps trading to the clinical testing of substances.
Aims :	The aim of the seminars is to offer an integrated approach of basic concept in preclinical research (chemistry toxicology required to advance a substance to a drug in clinical trials.
