Main themes :	In this training course the student confronts the concrete realities of the editing trade. It is the logical prolongation of course CLIB 2001 for students following the publishing branch. It allows the student to acquire mastery of professional page setting programmes and apply certain concepts studied in the context of theoretical courses.
