Main themes :	Beside an general introduction to biocompatibility, sterile medical equipment, prosthesis and implants used in various medical specialities are addressed.

Content :	 Biocompatibility Medical equipment, prosthesis and implants used in Anesthesiology (ventilation, perfusion, extra-corporeal circulation), in Invasive Radiology (catheters, embolisation material), in Nephrology (dialysis, renal replacement therapy), in Urology (urinary cathters), in Neurosurgery (drainage, replacement material), in Cardiac surgery (various types of cardiac valves), in plastic Surgery (reconstructive surgery) and Intensive Care Medicine (ventilation, haemodynamic monitoring) Lecture and presentation of materials
Other infos :	 Basic anatomic and physiologic knowledge are required as the lessons are mainly directed towards pharmacists. Some knowledge about frquent pathologies are also useful. The assessment is based on a written examination that mixes open questions and answers and multiple choice questions. Each co-titular is taking part in the elaboration and correction of the questions. As the course is mainly dedicated to the presentation, description and the operation of prosthesis, implants and biomaterial, the attendance to the lessons for material visualisation is warmly recommanded.
