Main themes :	<p>The course covers every day and familiar topics such as: moving house, asking the way, going to the doctor's, talking about holidays.</p> <p>Course activities cover the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-- Construction of grammatically correct sentences (orally and in writing)</li> <li>-- Exercises on new vocabulary in class</li> <li>-- Comprehension of a video conversation between Chinese people</li> <li>-- Group discussion of everyday topics</li> <li>-- Reading long texts on everyday topics</li> <li>-- Reading aloud short texts</li> <li>-- Development of vocabulary of synonyms and antonyms</li> <li>-- Creating short talks</li> <li>-- Learning Chinese games</li> </ul>
Aims :	<p>By the end of the course, the student should have acquired:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-- A knowledge of +/- 800 ideograms plus a passive knowledge of others</li> <li>-- Essential and complex grammar structures</li> <li>-- An extensive vocabulary</li> <li>-- The ability to understand conversations and long texts on current topics</li> <li>-- The ability to write about given subjects</li> <li>-- Some ability to read fairy tales and authentic articles</li> <li>-- A greater ability to talk about their studies and everyday life</li> </ul> <p><i>The contribution of this Teaching Unit to the development and command of the skills and learning outcomes of the programme(s) can be accessed at the end of this sheet, in the section entitled "Programmes/courses offering this Teaching Unit".</i></p>
Evaluation methods :	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-- Regular consolidation and revision exercises.</li> <li>-- General revision at the end of the year</li> <li>-- final exam : 50% oral, 50% written</li> </ul> <p>Students have to obtain 12/20 to be admitted to the advanced course.</p>
Teaching methods :	<p>Audiovisual method</p> <p>Each lesson comprises a mini-scenario presenting the theme of the lesson and the grammar. The lessons also include listening comprehensions of increasing speed.</p> <p>The grammar point covered are complex and essential for understanding more challenging texts and conversations.</p> <p>Each 4-hour lesson is made up as follows: 50% oral, 50% written work. Active learning and memorization of ideograms has to be done at home.</p>

Content :	This course aims to continue the development of vocabulary and the knowledge of essential and some complex grammatical structures. Learning these grammar points enables the student to tackle more challenging reading, to understand the language better and to speak with greater ease about studies and daily life.
Bibliography :	<p>There are 2 volumes of course notes to accompany the course: one contains ideograms and one the course notes as follows:</p> <p>--  Vocabulary and ideograms of the week  --  Vocabulary exercises  --  Grammar exercises  --  Reading and translation exercises  --  Texts to be studied (simplified and unabridged versions)  --  Weekly homework  --  Cultural texts</p> <p>The intermediate level course is also accompanied by 4 CDs comprising the course material covered.</p>
