Main themes :	<p>The course aims at improving listening and reading comprehension skills. Special communication techniques for professional purposes (meetings, business phone calls...) and presentation techniques will be included by means of special training. Each subject will be dealt with in detail by role plays and guided discussions which will also allow students to practise the new vocabulary and expressions.</p> <p>The students will make a presentation about a political or economic subject. They will also present a short part of a TV-news program. They will write summaries with personal comments and business letters which will proofread by the teacher.</p>
Aims :	<p>This course is for students of economics, management and political science. The aim of the course is to improve their oral skills and reading comprehension skills. The general aim is to enable students to express themselves in a social and professional context.</p> <p>Reading comprehension: - Can understand the main ideas of texts with a large degree of autonomy; can read normal correspondence related to his/her job B2+</p> <p>Listening Comprehension: Can understand a conference or a complex presentation on topics which are familiar or related to his field of specialization; can understand most broadcasts on topics which are familiar or related to his field of specialization; can understand in detail an everyday conversation. B2 level.</p> <p>Speaking skills: can make a presentation related to his/her field (having had some time for preparation) ; can have a conversation with a native speaker in a fluent, spontaneous and correct way; can keep up with a debate on his field of specialization. B2 level of the "Common European Framework for languages".</p> <p>Writing skills: can give a summary of information coming from different sources; can write a professional letter</p> <p>Code : ability to master the vocabulary related to his/her field of specialisation as well as simple and more complex structures of the Spanish language.
