Place of the course	Louvain-la-Neuve
Prerequisites :	Some instruction in the history of philosophy, especially an acquaintance with phenomenology, and some acquaintance with philosophical anthropology.
Main themes :	The theme of the course changes every year. But every year, anthropological questions will be pursued through the works of major authors of contemporary and modern philosophy, and the course will be concerned with examining how they are interpreted today.

Evaluation methods :	Assessment will be based on active presence during the lessons, the personal reading of Ricoeur's book (Ricoeur, 1965) and on a personal dissertation (+/- 25.000 s.) whose precise topic will constitute a contribution to the philosophical analysis of the main theme.
