Main themes :	Alternately with LGLOR2642A, this course deals with the following themes: For Aramean (first term) : 'a commented translation of extracts of Targums, of papyri from Elephantine and of Qumran texts (22.5 hours of course); ' personal translation of extracts of Targums or Qumran texts (7.5 hours of exercises).
Aims :	Mastery of detailed notions of the grammar of Aramean.
