Main themes :	Deepening of the knowledge of the stylistic trends in painting from the end of the middle ages to 17th century, as they developed outside Italy: Renaissance, Mannerism, Baroque, Classicism. Particularly the works of Dürer, Breugel and Rubens will be studied. An opening to the field of engraving and stained-glass will be proposed.
Aims:	The students will acquire a basic knowledge in the field of the painting from the 15th to the 17th centuries in the Southern Low Countries. Evaluation methods :	Assessment by final oral examination and/or written assignment.
Teaching methods :	Lectures by the teacher or invited lecturers. Conferences and visits in churches and Belgium museums are also organized.
