Main themes :	In relation to the course "questions spéciales - art contemporain", the seminar of this year will approach contemporary art through its ways of being displayed in museums in Belgian and abroad (Wiels, Brussels; MAC's, Grand-Hornu; MuHKA (Antwerp), S.M.A.K., Gent; Museum Ludwig (Cologne), etc.
Aims :	The course will deepen the knowledge about the production and the aesthetic concepts in contemporary art. It is the aim of the seminar that the student develops a critical sense and analytical methods as well as the ability to deal with a specific subject in contemporary art. Evaluation methods :	The students are evaluated on the basis of their active participation, a presentation, and a paper on a specific subject.
Teaching methods :	Group work : Conception of an exhibition + oral papers.
Content :	The course deals with artists' publications of the 1960s and 1970s. On the basis of works from the museums of Louvain-la-Neuve and of Mariemont, the students conceive an exhibition on the topic: « Experimental spaces. Artists' publications from the 1960s and 1970s ».
