Main themes :	This seminar will take up the student teaching experiences of students, and thanks to videotaping allow them to: - Compare their performance at different times and gain critical distance with regard to their own perceptions of live teaching; - Analyse the pedagogical methods of other students; - Implement theoretical ideas and models developed in the framework of other principles of good teaching practice.
Aims :	Upon completion of the course students should be able to reflect in a critical manner on their own teaching practices and to analyse them.
