Main themes :	To meet these objectives, the course consists in reading Greek texts mainly from the Gospels and Pauline letters. Particular attention will be paid to vocabulary and syntactic features.
Aims :	By the end of the course, the student should be able to: - read Greek texts from the New Testament (of average difficulty), using a dictionary and a grammar book; - verify the accuracy of a French translation.
