This course will be illustrated by numerous clinical cases and video recordings of surgical interventions. This course is assigned to the medical students from the first doctorate in medicin.
Aims :	This course is the indispensable complement to the course of general surgery and shall give, on a didactic and synthetic presentation, the basic principles of plastic surgery and their clinical applications.
