Prerequisites :	To be able to register for this course, the student should have followed two years of Spanish classes at secondary school, or stayed in a Spanish-speaking country for a prolonged period of time To be able to include Spanish on their programme, the student will have to take a compulsory placement test at the beginning of the first semester of BAC 1.					
Main themes :	This learning module is focused on communicative competence. Starting from various types of activities, the communication strategies, and productive, receptive, interactive and mediating skills are systematically developed, taking the A2 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages as a starting point. The themes tackled are: points of interest, student life, travel, civic participation, current events in the Spanish-speaking world, traditions and customs of certain Spanish-speaking countries, indigenous populations, as well as culture (cinema, music, theatre, literature, TV, etc.).					
Aims:	At the end of this learning module, the student should be able to:					
Evaluation methods :	Continuous assessment: Tests and presentations = 30 % of the final score; Final written exam = 40 % of the final score; Final oral exam = 30 % of the final score.					
Teaching methods :	Grammar is tackled using texts as a starting point (grammar-in-use); interactive classes, role-playing, debates on current events. The acquisition of vocabulary is implemented using the lexical approach.					

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Content :	This learning module aims at developing all the language and communication skills entrenched in a communicative, lexical and grammatical approach. The methodology is very varied and includes carrying out various assignments (written and oral) throughout the course, linked to the themes tackled.
