Main themes :	History of the instruments of Western music from the Middle Ages to the Present.

Evaluation methods :	The examination is scored according to the historical and theoretical knowledge of the student and observation capability.
Teaching methods :	Lectures illustrated with Powerpoint presentations.
Content :	The course shows the evolution of instruments in the history of Western music. It consists of a presentation based on many documents and iconographic sound. Each instrument is presented in its socio-cultural and musical, so that students can identify the resources and limitations. A portion of the course is devoted to the reading of scores, to show how the instruments are operated in the orchestra and various instrumental formations. As part of the course, a visit to the Musical Instruments Museum in Brussels is planned. Visits instrument workshops are also possible.
