The topics of the seminar will change from year to year but will focus on two main topics : 1) to enhance musical heritage of the Southern Netherlands through archival research; 2) to study musical collection, their contents and their elaboration; so that students become accustomed to survey technique and musical catalogues, to musical philology and music edition.
