Main themes	The course proposes a double perspective of analysis, both chronological and functional. It allows to piece together the key stages of the decision-making process: internal procedures proper to the main institutions, inter-institutional procedures, involvement of stakeholders. Several recent examples are provided.

Evaluation methods	Written or oral examination.
Content	Each political and legal stage composing the decision-making process is examined, from the impulsion by the European Council to the execution where the adoption of such measures is required. Among other topics, attention is paid to the programming cycle, the operation of the institutions and their organs as well as to complex procedures like the codecision and the comitology. Three case studies are provided: European banking Union, financial transaction tax and international accounting standards.
