During this course we will deal with the following in particular: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • introducing the students to information technology functionality and concepts and to the technical, legal and social challenges posed by the introduction of information and communication technologies, generally but also within their disciplines; • becoming familiar with basic administrative software; • exploring the possibilities offered by information technology for document research and processing information in their respective disciplines. These lessons will include both elements of theory and practical work.
