Aims	<p>By the end of the course the student: should be able to integrate the cultural dimension in his teaching of Dutch as a foreign language and he should be familiar with the linguistic aspects of this teaching. Content	The workshops will focus on specific didactic aspects of the teaching of Dutch as a foreign language. Students will be invited to read articles and prepare suitable teaching material. Students will then present their work in an oral exam
