Content	In this course students will have to manage/organize a subtitle project from German into French within a given/specifyed timeframe in the computer lab, from the order to the delivery of the final product, i.e. a subtitled document. They will use the program EZTitles®. The students will rely on the competences they acquired in the course and respect the norms described in the style guide and the quality norms specific to subtitles. They will work individually and with other group/team members.
