In the first part, the professor will give some lectures on the following topics:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. international migration and international trade, 2. skilled emigration and economic development, 3. the optimal migration duration, 4. the political economy of immigration policies, 5. the welfare and labour-market effects of immigration. <p>The second part will be based on presentations by (groups of) students, who are expected to read and summarize the findings of some recent research papers on various aspects of international migration.</p>
