Evaluation methods	<p>The evaluation is based on following criteria :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• translation of a non-French scientific article</li> <li>• oral examination on the course content, the auditory identification of musical instruments and the observation capabilities of instruments not studied during the course.</li> </ul>
Teaching methods	Lectures illustrated with Powerpoint presentations.
Content	<p>The course shows the evolution of instruments in the history of Western music. It consists of a presentation based on many documents and iconographic sound. Each instrument is presented in its socio-cultural and musical, so that students can identify the resources and limitations. A portion of the course is devoted to the reading of scores, to show how the instruments are operated in the orchestra and various instrumental formations.</p> <p>As part of the course, a visit to the Musical Instruments Museum in Brussels or to instrument workshops are possible.</p> <p>A personal paper written by the students, consisting in the translation of a scientific, non-French article, is required.</p>
