Main themes	- In order to achieve the objectives defined above, the instructor will combine grammatical and lexicographical explanations about NT Greek and practical exercises illustrating and developing the theoretical explanations. The student will be given biblical texts from the Gospels at as early a stage as possible.

Evaluation methods	Written exam: translation of a biblical passage and grammatical analysis of Greek words.
Teaching methods	The presence of the student in the class is required. Method: Teaching and exercises (translations from French to Greek, from Greek to French, analysis of grammatical forms) favouring comprehension and memorisation. The exercises are inspired from texts of the NT.
Content	Alphabet and reading; grammar (morphology: noun, pronoun and verb; syntax: elements); main vocabulary of NT Greek.
