Each student will be integrated in the framework of the research activities of a host laboratory conducting their research in the fields of biochemistry and/or molecular biology. Through this hands-on training the student will acquire technical skills as well as in-depth scientific knowledge about a limited but otherwise precise research topic. The goal of the thesis is to develop the student autonomy and sense of initiative in managing a research project, to foster his critical, rigorously scientific awareness and reflections on his/her research data and related scientific literature.
