An outline of the literary genres of Latin literature;</li> <li>2. A study of the choice of literary themes;</li> <li>3. A general presentation of the methods of transmission of Latin literature and of its aesthetic specificity.</li> </ol>
Aims	<p>At the end of this course, the student will have acquired a general view of the Latin literature, within a chronological and historic framework. He will be familiar with the Latin authors whose works are prescribed reading in the course.
