| Content | The course aims to analyze the nature and forms of expression of love in a large corpus of Spanish American contemporary poetic texts (Darío, Agustini, Neruda, Huidobro, Paz) and novels (Cortazar, Garcia Marquez, Roa Bastos, Manuel Puig). The analysis is conducted on the basis of theoretical considerations, coming mainly from philosophy and psychoanalysis. | | | | |
