Presentation of the results during a « class workshop » (20%), essay in article form (50%). Group exams (2 students) will be encouraged.</p> <p>20% of the final grade goes to language proficiency of the oral and written productions (grammatical and lexical code)</p> <p>10% goes to class work (reading notes, class preparations)</p>

Content	The seminar will investigate the impact of cognitive load on discourse production.
