Main themes	<p>In order to make students self-sufficient and critical in their research, they will be introduced to the critical and detailed study of a theological or literary question about ancient Christian literature or of a historical question about Christian antiquity :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Individually or in group students will be taught to practice a rigorous method ; - They will use specialised tools for patristics or history of Antiquity.
