Teaching methods	Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the information in this section is particularly likely to change. exchanges between participants, moderated by two approved general practitioners. The participants present to their peers the situations (clinical, administrative, relational, etc.) that they experienced during the course and which either gave them a problem or are illustrative. At the request of the participants, an external resource person may be exceptionally invited to participate in an exchange (health professional, social worker, lawyer, etc.)
Content	All subjects of a clinical nature (prevention, diagnosis, therapy, etc.), practical, administrative, relational, etc. as they are presented to the candidate GP in training within his internship system. The seminar is therefore based on the case study ("casuistry")
Inline resources	As the content of each seminar is very different depending on the situations reported by the participants, specific resources are not mentioned.
