| Evaluation methods | Several marks come into account for the final assessment: • continuous assessment 50% (written and oral tests, instructions and plan in course notes) • examen at week 13, 50%. Written test 25% (listening and reading 5%, grammar 5%, vocabulary 10% and writing 5%) and oral examen (25%). • the mark for the continuous assessment will not be considerated in the september session. September exam: written examen (listening and reading 10%, grammar 10%, vocabulary 20% and writing 10%) and oral examen (50%). These exam and teachingmodalities could be transposed to online teaching and learning according to the evolution of the health situation. |
| Teaching methods | Groups of 25 students maximum. Course hours: 30 hours in class and/or online Self-study: 42 hours. |
| Content | The activities are based on authentic documents (reading and listening comprehension). Basic vocabulary and structures are trained, reinforced and expanded via written and oral exercises (role-plays, interviews, conversations in small groups of 2 or 4, '). |
