Main themes	<p>The course covers every day and familiar topics such as: speaking about public transport, comparing distances, two objects or two people, eating out in restaurants, travel, going to the market, colours..</p> <p>Course activities cover the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• More challenging pronunciation with correct tones</li> <li>• Construction of sentences (orally and in writing)</li> <li>• Basic vocabulary exercises</li> <li>• Reading learnt texts aloud</li> <li>• Reading short unseen texts</li> <li>• Question/answer exercises</li> <li>• Writing simple texts</li> <li>• Learning a new series of classifiers</li> <li>• Dictation</li> </ul>
Learning outcomes	<p><b>At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to :</b></p> <p>By the end of the course, the student should have acquired:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rapid identification of tones, reproduction of sounds which are difficult to pronounce</li> <li>• More fluent writing of ideograms</li> <li>• Basic grammar structures and a more developed basic vocabulary</li> <li>• Easier comprehension of messages relating to simple and familiar situations</li> <li>• (+/-) 250 new ideograms</li> <li>• The ability to create simple sentences</li> <li>• The ability to compare and to talk about a day's events</li> <li>• The ability to read simple texts using the vocabulary learnt</li> <li>• The ability to use a Chinese dictionary</li> </ul>
Evaluation methods	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. General revision at the end of the year.</li> <li>2. Q1 test (partial written exam) represents 4 points of the final mark.</li> <li>3. Final exam:                         <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>8 points (oral),</li> <li>12 points (written)</li> </ul> </li> <li>4. Learners have to obtain 10/20 to be admitted to the elementary level II</li> </ol>
Teaching methods	<p><b>Audiovisual method</b></p> <p>Each lesson comprises a mini-scenario presenting the theme of the lesson</p> <p>Each lesson also develops one or more grammar points, the various grammatical objects, complex concepts of tense, classifiers, comparison etc</p> <p>Each 4-hour lesson is made up as follows: 40% oral, 60% written work.</p> <p>In additional, there is homework.</p>
Content	<p>This course aims to develop vocabulary and to increase knowledge of grammar. This will enable students to talk with some confidence about everyday activities, to read and write more easily and to make themselves understood in specific situations. The students also learn to use a Chinese dictionary.</p>
