Evaluation methods	Continuous evaluation on the basis of individual and group work carried out during the quadrimester. Modalities of the second session are identical: individual and group work, carried out on topics covered dur the course.					
Teaching methods	In addition to presentation sessions of digital tools, the course will focus as much as possible on the practic of these tools by students. Individual or group work will therefore be requested at the end of each module a then be discussed during the course. Covid-19 - All of the course sessions are given face to face. - Depending on the evolution of health measures (yellow or orange codes), on the capacity of the auditoriu on the number of registered students, seminar sessions could switch to co-modality: presence of the maji students, and the possibility of remote attendance via Teams. If the auditorium does not allow broadcast Teams or if red code applies, these courses will go into full remote mode. These adaptations will be commun to students via Moodle.					
Content	The course is structured in modules each dealing with a specific field of digital journalism and allowing to addres the themes described above. The main modules are: basic web tools, the production of journalistic podcasts, mobil journalism (MoJo) and live blogging, data journalism (data journalism and big data), protection of information an sources.
