It covers the following elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The origin and place of surveys in the production of knowledge in social sciences. • The main stages in the design and organisation of a survey (definition of objectives, population, etc.) • Sampling techniques • Questionnaire design • Practical organization of a survey <p>The course includes an important practical component in the LSOC2095 course, which is combined with this course (and is compulsory). In particular, students are required to construct and test a survey module and propose a sample design.</p>
