Teaching methods	 Theoretical presentations Presentation/dialogue with professionals invited to share their practices and experiences Partnership with producers or archive services (visit, fieldwork, etc.)
Content	The course will specifically address one of the missions of the archivist: • supervision/advice. E.g.: carrying out an audit of a producer service; • evaluation, acquisition, opening to research. E.g.:, creation of a sorting table, an inventory, etc.; • conservation. E.g.: Evaluation and treatment of a vulnerable collection (contamination, unfavorable environment, etc.); restoration process of specific pieces; • dissemination. E.g.: creation of a (virtual) exhibition highlighting an archival heritage.
