Teaching methods	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Theoretical presentations • Presentation/dialogue with professionals invited to share their practices and experiences • Partnership with producers or archive services (visit, fieldwork, etc.)
Content	The course will specifically address one of the missions of the archivist: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • supervision/advice. E.g.: carrying out an audit of a producer service; • evaluation, acquisition, opening to research. E.g. : creation of a sorting table, an inventory, etc. ; • conservation. E.g.: Evaluation and treatment of a vulnerable collection (contamination, unfavorable environment, etc.); restoration process of specific pieces; • dissemination. E.g.: creation of a (virtual) exhibition highlighting an archival heritage.
