Content	This Consecutive Interpreting Practise is a follow-up to the previous 1Q Consecutive Interpretive Course (LINTP2360) Basically this Unit carries over the same objectives : in-depth understanding and analysis of a speech in Russian, improving note-taking skills, the faithfull rendition of the speaker's train of thoughts, a fair knowledge of the Russian world stakes and its cultural pecularities, the accuracy and fluencey of the target language (hence French), quality communicative skills. The speeches in Russian address subject-matters linked to society and on-going news in the Russian Federation, with increasing length and density as compared to the first term.
