Evaluation methods	Validation of LING2891 is granted in the first year provided that the student writes a state of the art chapter with a reference list (min. 25 entries).
Teaching methods	Students should contact their supervisors. The differences between the disciplines and topics taught in LING imply that the teaching methods depend on the topic of the dissertation. The supervisors may organize traditional seminars or offer one-on-one encounters with the students.
Content	Introduction to specific methodologies according to the chosen discipline.
Other infos	Students should look into and carefully examine previous dissertations. The chosen supervisor will guide the student.
